<b>ALL INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL</b>	<p>Must register travel in the University Travel Registry</p> <p>Requested to sign in through the University Travel Registry for University approved travel abroad health insurance</p>	<p>Must register travel in the University Travel Registry</p> <p>Must obtain University approved travel abroad health insurance</p>
<p><b>UNIVERSITY TRAVEL WARNING* DESTINATIONS</b></p> <p>Definition: Travel is unadvisable while the warning is in effect due to a <i>significant level</i> of health, safety or security risks</p> <p>Example: 1. <i>Egypt due to civil unrest (January 2011)</i></p>	<p>Must register travel in the University Travel Registry</p> <p>Requested to sign in through the University Travel Registry for University approved travel abroad health insurance</p>	<p>Students cannot be required to participate in activities in these destinations</p> <p>Regular (annual) programs may be suspended</p> <p>Individual students may submit a request with a written safety plan (<i>see template</i>) to ITOC for an exception to travel to these destinations. If approved, they will be required to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Register in the University Travel Registry</li> <li>- Obtain University approved travel abroad health insurance</li> <li>- Submit an Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability form with ITOC (<i>form provided</i>)</li> </ul> <p>Faculty and staff may submit a request with a written safety plan (<i>see template</i>) to ITOC for an exception to lead student groups to these destinations. If approved, the group leader must ensure students:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Register in the University Travel Registry</li> <li>- Obtain University approved travel abroad health insurance</li> <li>- Submit an Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability form with ITOC (<i>form provided</i>)</li> </ul>
<p><b>UNIVERSITY TRAVEL RESTRICTION* DESTINATIONS</b></p> <p>Definition: Travel, for University-related purposes, is generally prohibited while the restriction is in effect due to <i>extreme</i> health, safety or security risks</p> <p>Examples: 1. <i>Northern Mexico due to severe violence and criminal activity (April 2010 – present)</i></p> <p>2. <i>Northern Japan due to earthquake, tsunami, and nuclear reactor meltdown (March 2011)</i></p> <p>3. <i>Afghanistan due to ongoing warfare and terrorism</i></p> <p>4. <i>China during first stages of SARS outbreak when acuity and pandemic infectious risk had not been established (March 2003)</i></p>	<p>Travel is discouraged</p> <p>Evacuations or removal may be required</p> <p>Must register travel in the University Travel Registry</p> <p>Expected to submit an Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability form with ITOC (<i>form provided</i>)</p> <p>Requested to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Sign in through the University Travel Registry for University approved travel abroad health insurance</li> <li>- Submit a written safety plan to ITOC (<i>see template</i>)</li> </ul>	<p>Travel for undergraduates for University-related purposes is prohibited</p> <p>Evacuation of undergraduate students is required (and may be necessary for graduate or professional students)</p> <p>Graduate or professional students may submit a request with a written safety plan (<i>see template</i>) to ITOC for an exception to travel to these destinations. If approved, they will be required to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Register in the University Travel Registry</li> <li>- Obtain University approved travel abroad health insurance</li> <li>- Submit an Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability form with ITOC (<i>form provided</i>)</li> </ul>
